

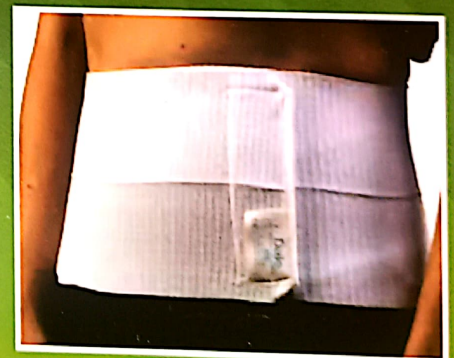

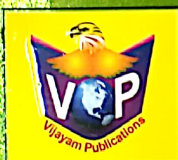

**F**irst Aid module is written according to the prescribed new syllabus of INC, New Delhi for the first Semester of first B.Sc. Nursing with much care. First Aid is the Provision of immediate care to a victim with an injury or illness, usually affected by a lay person and performed within a limited skill range. Updated Health concepts are described in detail to enable nursing students besides elaborating Maslow's hierarchy of needs. Basic concepts of Health care delivery system, levels of care, types of health care agencies and hospital functions are explained to alert the students in providing First Aid. The concept, nature and scope of nursing and its values in addition to professional conduct are explained. Detailed process of communication with patient and the relationship between patient and nurse, effective communication with the family or team members of patients are narrated to guide the nursing students in their nursing profession.

Guidelines for preparation of nursing documents and reports in duties, and the methods of changing shift reports, incidental reports are explained in an easy understanding method. Narrated guidelines for taking vital signs of the patients in the hospital, duly assessing and recording accurately. Use of everyday equipments and linen and its maintenance, placing indent for supply and inventory procedures are explained.

Described about the basic principles and techniques of infection and its control, and the methods how to identify and meet the comfort needs of the patient are also detailed. Much effort has been taken in explaining about the procedure and guidelines in admitting the patient in the hospital, transfer and discharge after recovery. Explained in detail about the basic principles, scope and rules in providing First Aid during emergencies and its management procedure when meet the patient with wounds, hemorrhages, shock, respiratory problems etc.,

This text consists of 14 units and for every unit at the beginning key terms and Overview at the ending are given to have a glance understanding about the chapters. Review Questions, MCQ etc., are given at the end of the chapters to evaluate the standard of the students.
