Symbiosis College of Nursing organized a Seminar on Gender Equity and Maternal Health In India: Trends And Issues, 131 delegates have attended the Seminar. The concept note of the seminar: Gender equity is defined and perpetuated by social norms and culture and reflects differences in power between men and women both within the household and in the wider society. The impact includes relatively higher rate of poverty and lower level of education among women than men do. Women lack autonomy and mobility, intimate partner violence and overall lower social status and disempowerment of women relative to men. Gender equity and women's low social status disempowerment significantly affect women's health. This increases the overall demand on maternal health services in India.

The Seminar was commenced on Dec 4, 2019 at 8am with registration of delegates followed by a series of sessions taken by the speakers
