Career Orientation Program

Date: 7th May 2025

Venue: Classroom no.404, Symbiosis College of Nursing

Introduction:

An insightful and encouraging career orientation program was organized at Symbiosis College

of Nursing on 7th May 2025 in classroom no.404. The program aimed to provide the students

with valuable insights into various career paths in the nursing and healthcare sectors. The

session was attended by BSc. Nursing VII semester students and MSc. Nursing students along

with Faculty members. The program was organized by Dr. Ranjana Chavan, Assistant professor

at symbiosis college of nursing.

Objectives of the program:

To enlighten students about diverse career opportunities post-graduation.

To guide students in making informed career decisions.

To inspire students through real-life experiences shared by professionals.

Details of the program:

The event began at 8.30 AM with the welcome address to all the attendees of the program

emphasizing the importance of early career planning and exposure.

Speakers and Highlights:

1. Ms. Angela Wolf- Managing Director (Cura Connect, Germany)

Session- Emerging Career Opportunities in Nursing in Germany.

She spoke about career growth in Germany for nurses, opportunities for fresher

nurses, the employment opportunities, process regarding applying for Germany and

guidance for settling there along with the exposure to the salary offers and licensing.

The guidance for learning the language, the visa process was also explained. She

also mentioned how one can connect with the Cura Connect and they will guide the

students through the whole process elaborating the accommodation and living

expenses. The focus was made on the area focusing the high demand of nurses in Germany in current scenario.

2. Ms. Diksha Saini- Register Nurse, Long term care (Nova Scotia, Canada) Session- Single Mindedness to reach Canada- Dream of a nurse.

Ms. Diksha shared her experience and her journey through becoming a registered nurse in Canada. She shared what all challenges she faced in her career and why she chose Canada as a career option. She shared the real-life experience which made the students cleared about the opportunities and challenges that one can face during the career building in Canada. She also mentioned the years of experience required, the job opportunities, the salary offer and the exams and interviews one need to face. She also shared her email through which students can clear any doubt they have.

3. Mrs. Sarita Rajput- Nutrition and Fitness Consultant (Fitter Company, Delhi) Vision to Venture: The Entrepreneurial Journey.

Madam has previously served as an army nurse and is now currently working as a Nutrition and Fitness Consultant. She shared why she chose consultant as a profession and how she grew at her career from nursing to aspiring consultant changing thousands of people's lives with proper nutritional guidance and support. She shared her experience of choosing a different career path but how the nursing knowledge helps her to be more involved with patients and monitor them efficiently as the education she gained in nursing has been working as a base for her career. She also emphasized that nursing is a very wide career option and after the completion of nursing degree one can explore many other career opportunities.

4. Ms. Madhura Waghmare- Nursing Superintendent (Inlaks Budrani Hospital, Pune)

Session- Exploring Private Sector Employment Pathways in Nursing.

She acknowledged the growing nursing career and elaborated how a person can grow in a career step by step, like what is the initial joining stage as a fresher nurse and how one can increase the experience and knowledge along with growing in the career. She explained how and when one can join various private sector hospitals and what are the opportunities and challenges one can face. Also, the growth in nursing career in India was emphasized focusing on what all practices are provided to the students. She also

provided the options for joining in private sectors giving an idea of what are the various levels and scopes.

Mr. Vaibhav Bhagwat (University Hospital Galway, Ireland) Session- Challenges and opportunities in the World of Wonder-Ireland.

Sir addressed the gathering and shared how he became a registered nurse in Ireland. He also shared why he chose Ireland to build his career and what was the process for flying to the country. He also shared the important requirement that one needs to have to apply for registered nurse in Ireland. He explained the process step by step and provided the guiding companies to help apply for Ireland. He explained the years of experience required along with the examination one needs to appear and the aptitude test and visa permit process. Sir also shared his real-life experience how he found the experience in Ireland different than in India.

6. Ms. Kalyani Wakhare- Alumni Nursing Officer (AIIMS Bibinagar, Hyderabad) Session- Hot and Happening placement at AIIMS.

Madam started the session with a brief explanation about what the requirements are and how one can apply for the AIIMS. She also elaborated on how one can prepare for the examination and what books and academies that can help with the preparation are. She also shared her real-life experiences with students and how she appeared on the exam. She also shared the salary package and the working environment in the hospital. The focus of the session was on how a fresher nurse can join the hospital and what all challenges and opportunities one needs to face.

At the end of every session the speakers acknowledged the students and cleared the doubts students were having.

Conclusion:

The program was concluded at 12 PM with a vote of thanks delivered by the student representative. The Career Orientation Program was a great success proving students with a broader perspective and motivating them to explore diverse professional avenues in nursing.










