Faculty of Medical and Health Science (FoMHS)

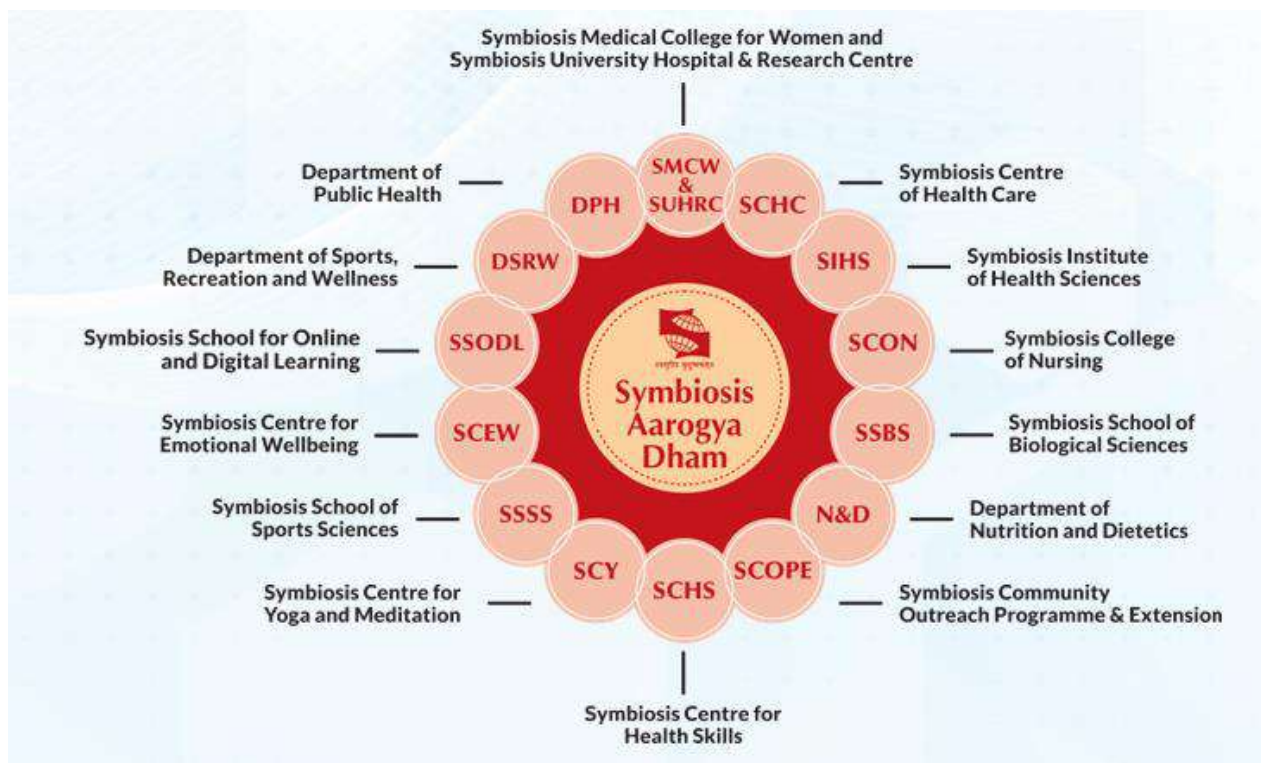

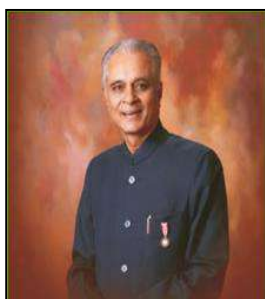


Symbiosis College of Nursing (SCON)

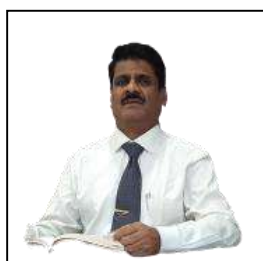

ABOUT CONFERENCE:

The concept is driven by asking questions and seeks to administer more natural and less invasive care solutions. The concept of integrative care constantly is evolving and being improved. Integrative care practitioners are personally committed to exploring and developing new treatment options. Through integrative care, patients are empowered to develop healthy behaviors and skills for use on a daily basis. Integrative care strategies may include mind-body therapies, nutritional guidance, meditation, resilience training, massage therapy, acupuncture and herbal/nutritional medicine. The principles of integrative nursing and caring science align with the unitary paradigm in a way that can inform and shape nursing knowledge, patient care delivery across populations and settings, and new healthcare policy. The proposed policies may transform the healthcare system in a way that supports nursing praxis and honors the discipline's unitary paradigm. This call to action provides a distinct and hopeful vision of a healthcare system that is accessible, equitable, safe, patient-centered, and affordable.

Integrative nursing shifts the focus from curing to healing, thus changing the nature of problem solving and prioritizing. This does not imply that biomedical interventions are discarded; rather they are introduced when that level of intervention is warranted. Nurses practicing from an integrative perspective are not merely “adding on” integrative therapies. Rather, integrative therapies become core to their practice.

Integrative nursing as a care delivery model can be used as a strategy for mitigating the challenges faced by today’s acute care nurses. The goals of implementing integrative nursing are to improve the care experience of the patient and family, improve symptom management, and enhance the patient and family’s capacity to cope.

OBJECTIVES

- Highlights how nursing knowledge changes policy in practice and significant aspects of Integrative Nursing that arise when nurses are required to enforce policy that conflicts with nursing theory
- Address the system approach which targets the needs of patients and their families who are demanding care that is comprehensive, coordinated, and attentive to the whole person— body, mind and spirit
